





Yamaguchi City is a city of Feng shui!? Kyoto style city planning

The foundation of Yamaguchi City was created by Hiroyo Ouchi, 24th generation of the Ouchi clan who was appointed to govern the provinces of Nagato and Suo, now Yamaguchi Prefecture. By adapting Kyoto style city planning with a concept of Feng Shui, he used the Ichinosakagawa River to resemble the Kamogawa River in Kyoto. Also, the Mori clan who governed Yamaguchi area after the Ouchi clan continued adapting the concept of the Feng shui to the city planning in Yamaguchi. The entire Yamaguchi City is an empowered spot with the Feng shui concept admired by the Ouchi and the Mori clans!

The Feng shui is a practice emerged in China and became prevalent across the East Asia. Fate and fortune are judged by analyzing directions of "Qi or Ch'i" flows, or flows of vital forces.


