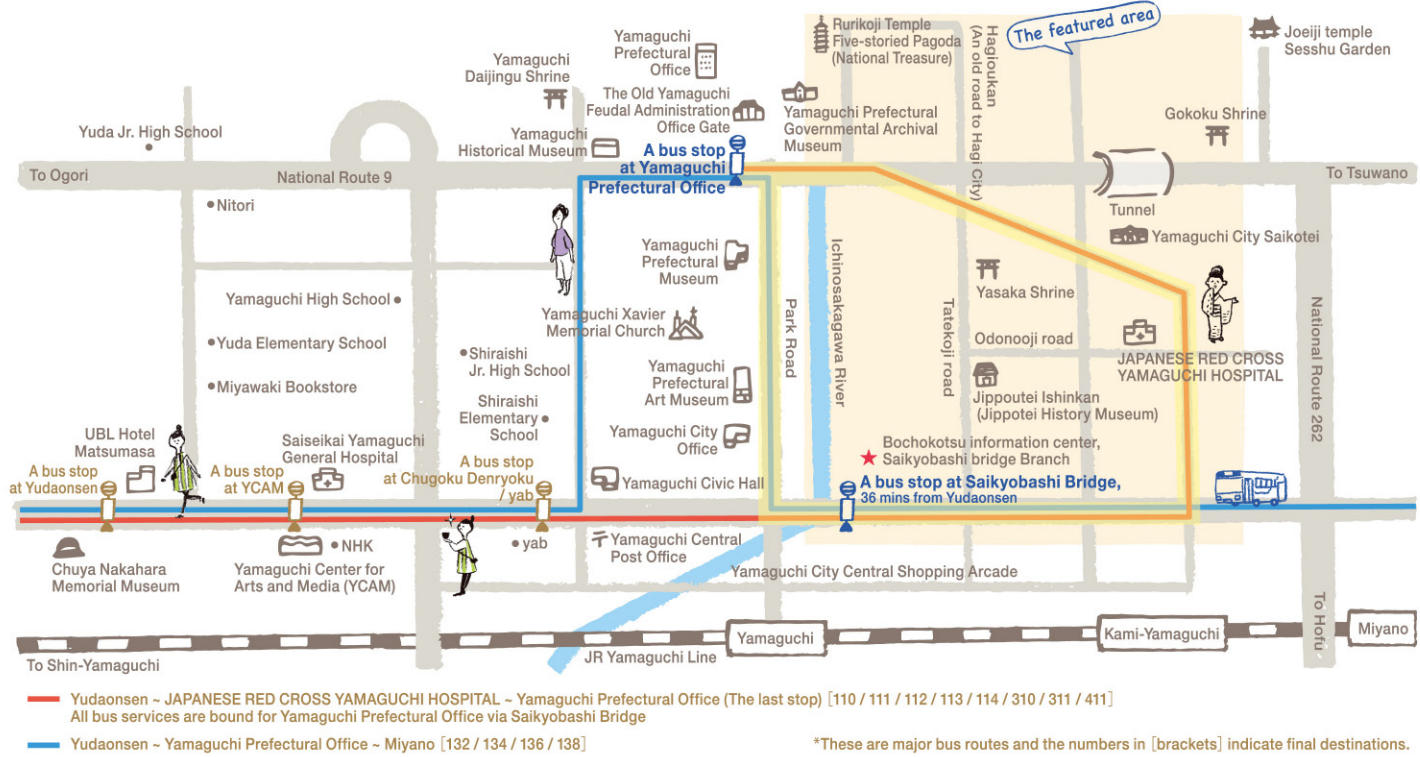

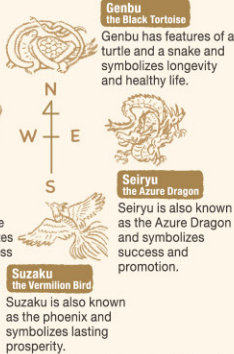


Here are some travel tips to make your experience more exciting and fun if you know this ahead of your walk from Yamaguchi Prefectural Government Office bus stop to the Saikyobashi Bridge bus stop ☆

**Yamaguchi City is a city of Feng shui!? Kyoto style city planning**

The foundation of Yamaguchi City was created by Hiroyo Ouchi, 24th generation of the Ouchi clan who was appointed to govern the provinces of Nagato and Suo, now Yamaguchi Prefecture. By adapting Kyoto style city planning with a concept of Feng Shui, he used the Ichinosakagawa River to resemble the Kamogawa River in Kyoto. Also, the Mori clan who governed Yamaguchi area after the Ouchi clan continued adapting the concept of the Feng shui to the city planning in Yamaguchi. The entire Yamaguchi City is an empowered spot with the Feng shui concept admired by the Ouchi and the Mori clans!

The Feng shui is a practice emerged in China and became prevalent across the East Asia. Fate and fortune are judged by analyzing directions of "Qi or Ch'i" flows, or flows of vital forces.

Ichinosakagawa River Landscapes**

Cherry blossoms and the night illuminations in spring, luminous Genji-botaru (a nationally-designated important intangible cultural property) in early summer .... Ichinosakagawa River represents one of the major tourist spots in Yamaguchi City. In autumn, you can take an extensive walk to the Park Road to appreciate the seasonal red leaves, and in winter illuminations can be enjoyed at "Ichinosakagawa Park for Information & Cultural Events"!



**Kimono and Bakumatsu shishi dress ups!**

At the Saikotei and the Oji lobby, you can dress up in kimonos, traditional Japanese clothes, and historical costumes like Bakumatsu shishi, important historical figures from the mid 19th century who contributed for the Meiji restoration! Why don't you try them on and take photographs of you walking through historic Yamaguchi City for SNS?

### 1 Toshunji Temple

A family temple of Motonari Mori. The gate and the Kannon-do were built circa 1400 and both are registered important cultural properties in Japan. A famous Japanese dog monk "Maru" awaits you!

### 2 Rurikoji Temple Five-storied Pagoda (National Treasure)

A five-storied pagoda built by Moriharu Ouchi. It is considered one of the three most beautiful pagodas in Japan and expresses the elegance of the Ouchi culture.

### 9 Tokyoan

A soba noodle shop opened in 1924, the 13th year of the Taisho period. The most popular menu is "Soba Sushi". It is a sushi roll with soba noodles, the unique texture is addictively delicious!

### 3 Yamaguchi City Saikotei

Originally a historical restaurant operating for 120 years until 1996 and then transferred to the current site. The Saikotei was an important guesthouse in Yamaguchi to welcome successive Japanese Prime Ministers and displays their calligraphies and some other archives.

Built with ceremonial transfer of a deity from Kyoto Yasaka Shrine. The main building is a registered important cultural property in Japan. It is famous by its deity of love relationships.

### 6 Ryufukuji Temple

Founded by Mitsumori Ouchi in 1206, the first year of the Ken'ei period. After the Mori clan defeated Yoshinaga Ouchi, the temple was relocated and rebuilt at the current location as a family temple of Yoshitaka Ouchi.

### 10 Toshiro Ouchi Branch

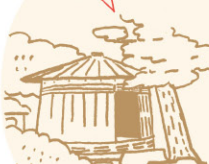


They have a tearoom, too!
